Spring Best Ball Golf Tournament**

Tee times will be sent out via email from the tournament administrator. It is your responsibility to keep information on your tee time.

Be prepared for all weather conditions.

Men play from the white tees. Women play from the red tees.

Play Format

1. Teams of 2 golfers. 2 alternates may also be listed. Teams may be 2 men, 2 women or coed
2. Each player plays his/her own ball
3. After finishing the hole, the lower score between partners is recorded for the team score
4. Play is from the white tees for men and the red tees for women
5. Winter rules apply: You may move ball within 6 inches of resting position, not nearer to the hole

Eligibility

1. Current U of O students, faculty and staff
2. EVERY PLAYER MUST SIGN THE ROSTER BEFORE PARTICIPATING
3. Varsity golf athletes are not eligible
4. The 2 players listed, the alternates, or any combination may be used – NO substitutes

Equipment

1. Each golfer supplies their own equipment
2. Proper attire is mandatory

Scoring

1. Each team should record their own score as well as the score of the other two-some in their group
2. When you have hit twice as many shots as par (e.g. 6 on a Par 3) pick up the ball, walk to the green and putt. Count your strokes, including putts for your score
3. U.S.G.A Rules will govern play (read your rule guide) except for specific course ground rules which are outlined on the back of the official score card. *EXCEPTION: Any ball that is deemed to be out of bounds (O.B.) or lost: Please play O.B. under the rules of a lateral water hazard. Walk to the point where the ball crossed the margin of the out of bounds line. Drop the ball within 2 club lengths of the point of entry, no closer to the hole. The penalty in this case is only 1 stroke
4. The Callaway Handicapping System will be used to figure net scores

Golf Etiquette

1. Please replace divots, smooth all marks made in sand traps and repair all ball marks on the greens
2. Do not play until the players in front of you are out of range
3. Balls may be cleaned on green and divots repaired prior to putting
4. In order to keep play moving you do not need to use tee honors
5. Slow play is NOT acceptable. Spend no more than 5 minutes looking for a lost ball
6. You and your partner are a team and may assist each other with advice or exchanging putting honors. When your partner has holed out with a score you can only tie or be over; you are encouraged to pick up and move on. Clear greens as soon as last player putts out. Figure and record scores on next tee

Contests

1. Tournament director will have a handout of contest holes
2. Closest to the pin holes – must be tee shot
3. Closest to the pin from off the green – must be second shot
4. Longest putt – must be putted from on the green (excludes fringe)
5. Longest drive – ball must come to rest in the fairway

Additional Information

- Please be sure to report to the starter 45 minutes before tee time.
- Allow at least 1-1.5 hours of driving time to Tokatee. (Leaving Eugene 2 hours and 15 minutes before tee time should allow time for checking in and warm-up before tee time).
- The team will be disqualified if both members have not checked in with the supervisor 15 minutes before their appointed tee time. Failure of one team member to meet tee time will result in the individual acting as a team.
- If the twosome you are paired with doesn't show, you and your partner will play as a twosome
